

## **December 2011 - LAGIC Report**

**Training:** LAGIC has scheduled ArcGIS I, II and III Workshops in Baton Rouge, Lafayette and New Orleans this winter and spring, as well as an ArcGIS I Workshop in Lake Charles in late January and an ArcGIS III workshop in mid February in Houma.

LAGIC will be sponsoring a one day workshop on Address Standards on January 12<sup>th</sup> in New Orleans. This workshop will be taught by Martha Wells. We plan to bring this workshop to Baton Rouge in February or March depending on Martha's schedule.

LAGIC will be hosting a US Census Bureau Workshop at LSU on Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup>. The one-day workshop will cover the Boundary and Annexation Survey.

### **Outreach**

LAGIC is over 80 % complete with our Pilot Addressing Project in West Carroll Parish. We have been asked by Morehouse Parish if we would assist in completing their digital address database.

LAGIC is working with the GIS Council, Kathrine Cargo and the Louisiana Chapter of NENA on an Address Maintenance Plan. The draft plan will go out for review to LaNENA Members this January.

LAGIC gave a demonstration of our addressing maintenance application at the US Census Bureau HQ at their Geospatial Summit in late November

LAGIC will soon begin work on USGS funded Structures Project Phase III. We have already met with Cameron, Tangipahoa and Vermillion Parish Staff to collect base data.
