The LGISC generated the following draft resolution as a statement of support to the Louisiana Database Commission.

"The Louisiana Geographic Information Systems Coordinating Council strongly supports the development of the 1998 Color Infrared Digital Orthophoto Quarter Quads (DOQQ) for the state of Louisiana. This high-resolution image data set will provide the geospatial 'framework' needed by state agencies and local governments to develop coordinated, integrated geospatial data. In addition, as one of the seven 'framework' data layers identified by the federal government to comprise the National Spatial Data Infrastructure, the DOQQ's will greatly support Louisiana's efforts to build local data sets of national value".
