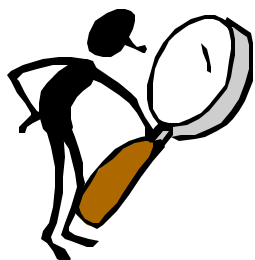

## Census 2000 Sample Data for Louisiana Is Here!

- Summary File 3 consists of 813 detailed tables of Census 2000 social, economic and housing characteristics compiled from the sample questionnaire. Examples of the data are ...
  - Social & Economic:** Disability, Income, Poverty, Commuting, Educational Attainment, Ancestry, Housing; Urban/Rural, Vehicles Available, Monthly Rent, Value of Home, Year Built, etc.
- Fifty-one tables are repeated for nine major race and Hispanic groups
- Summary File 3 presents data for the United States and the 50 states in a hierarchical sequence down to the block group for many tabulations, but only to the census tract levels for others. Summaries are included for other geographic areas such as Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs).
